Click and Collect

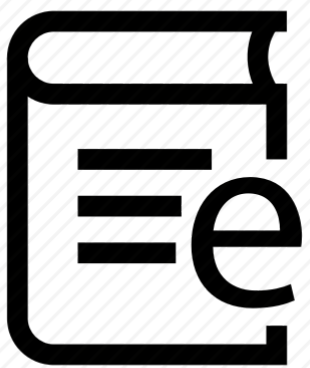
Browse the online library catalogue on library.griffith.ie, and email your requests. We will get back to you to arrange a pick up time.

All returned books will be quarantined for 3 days and then discharged from borrowers' accounts. During this quarantine period no fines will accrue. In the Dublin campus, books may be returned to the book returns box on the ground floor of the link block, by the lift.



eBooks

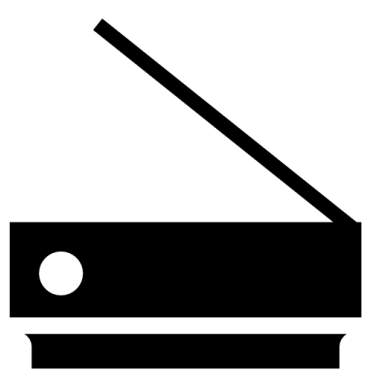
There are many eBooks available to view through the library catalogue, and we are adding to these all the time. If there is an electronic version of a book available, a link to the online copy will be made available on the catalogue record.



Scan on Request

The Library has launched a scan on request service for scanned copies of print book chapters. The service applies to textbooks not within the scope of Click & Collect, such as Library Use Only reference books.

This service is also designed to support those students who are not in a position to physically visit the library to avail of Click & Collect. It is operated under strict adherence to relevant copyright legislation.
